The City of Greater Sudbury Communities Building Youth Futures Initiative (CBYF) is a community collaboration that brings together people from many sectors to address issues of youth engagement in school and work in our community. Working within a collective impact framework, you will work with the community on an initiative to support youth to navigate transitions through high school to graduation, post-secondary education, training, and employment. You will be an employee of Child & Community Resources, which is a community partner for the CBYF Initiative in the City of Greater Sudbury. Child & Community Resources/Ressources pour l'Enfance et la Communauté (CCR/REC) offers a wide range of services for children, youth, families and professionals, to support the inclusion, integration, and wellbeing of children and youth. It is CCR/REC's goal to provide high-quality services throughout the North region of Ontario.

Reporting to the Lead Coordinator, as the Youth Engagement Coordinator, you will be responsible for identifying and supporting youth to become engaged in the Communities Building Youth Futures Initiative at various levels, including:

- Providing input through various means such as surveys, focus groups, workshops, social media, etc.
- Providing ideas on how to support youth who do engage with the CBYF Initiative
- Sitting on CBYF tables, committees, etc.
- Providing feedback on ideas generated by the community
- Develop a plan to support and sustain ongoing youth engagement through the rest of the project
- Ensure youth feedback and advice on the issues in the CBYF Initiative related to underrepresented youth who are not engaged in employment or education
- Support and mentor youth who are engaged to do so safely and confidently
- Train and model to adults how to work effectively with youth
- Teach, model, encourage, practice developmental relationships with youth who are engaged
- Provide active support of youth at all CBYF meetings and events
- Research and gather data on youth and youth transition
- Review, analyze and present the data in various ways (handouts, presentations, etc.)
- Participate in community mapping process and documenting of community assets
- Research and share innovative solutions and results from other communities



You are self-motivated with a genuine commitment to helping others. You exhibit patience, persistence, flexibility, and are able to deal with uncertainty and change. You are an active learner who is willing to lead and support initiatives while being prepared to give others credit. You are an individual who leads by example and can build trust.
